*Masks are required at all times while in the building except while seated and socially distanced from others, and only while listening to the sermon.



What to Expect

Before You Arrive

NEW Gathering Time. Beginning July 19, Sunday gatherings will begin at 9:30am and finish around 10:30am. This temporary change will allow us to help accommodate other local churches (such as [Risen Christ Fellowship](#) who are unable to gather, socially distanced, in their own building) using the building on Sundays.

Bring Your Mask. At this time, we're asking that anyone over the age of 2 wear a mask while in the building. If you forget your mask, we'll provide one for you. If you would like to remove your mask during the gathering, you may do so only while you're seated and socially distanced from others and only during the sermon (we'll be ensuring socially distanced seating). Once you've left the building, you're free to remove your mask at your convenience!

Enter and Exit Through Any Main Level Entrance. All entrances *except* those on the Main Level will be closed. The building will open and close 15 minutes before and after Sunday gatherings.

Coffee and Refreshments. Unfortunately, we will not be providing coffee or refreshments until further notice.

While You're Here

Touch-Free Entrances and Hands-Free Sanitizers. From parking lot to pew, we will do everything we can to provide you and your family with a touchless experience. Hands-free sanitation stations will be situated near all designated entrances for your convenience.

Finding a Seat. For your safety, seating in the Main Auditorium and Multipurpose Room will only be available every other pew or row. We ask that you help us prioritize safety by ensuring you and/or your household are spaced at least 6 feet (i.e. two arms' length) apart from others.

Social Distancing. We will do everything we can to ensure social distancing is practiced. One way you can help us encourage this practice is by keeping your distance from one another while having conversations and avoiding common greetings like handshakes and hugs.

Bulletins. We will not be providing bulletins at this time.

Building Cleanliness. Maintaining a safe and clean environment is one of our highest priorities. All restrooms will be properly cleaned and sanitized in compliance with [CDC/EPA guidelines](#) before and immediately after every gathering.



Regathering FAQ

1. What time will we gather on Sundays?

Beginning July 19, our gathering will begin promptly at 9:30am.

2. What time will the building open and close on Sundays?

The building will open at 9:15am and close at 10:45am.

3. How long will our gatherings be?

We will do our best to ensure Sunday gatherings are kept to an hour.

4. How many people will be allowed to gather in the building at once?

It's recommended that churches planning to reopen hold gatherings that do not exceed 50% room capacity and abide by CDC guidelines when gathered. During Phase 1, we will not exceed more than 40% room capacity for the Main Auditorium and Multipurpose Room (or ~200 people). During Phase 2, we will not exceed more than 50% room capacity for the Main Auditorium and Multipurpose Room (or ~250 people).

5. I am part of the vulnerable/high risk population. What should I do?

If you are part of the vulnerable/high risk population, we encourage you to do what your conscience permits. If you have concerns about your health, or about the health of somebody in your family, we would encourage you to stay home and [join us online](#) for the time being. Though we long to gather with you, we don't want you to do anything that unnecessarily puts you or anyone else at risk.

6. What entrances should I use?

All Main Level entrances will be available for use. All other entrances will be closed.

7. Will I be required to wear a mask?

At this time, we're asking that anyone over the age of 2 wear a mask while in the building. If you forget your mask, we'll provide one for you. If you would like to remove your mask during the gathering, you may do so only when you're seated and socially distanced from others and only during the sermon. Once you've left the building, you're free to remove your mask at your convenience!

8. Will there be TrinityKids?

There will not be TrinityKids on Sundays until further notice.

9. Can my kids join me for the gathering?

Absolutely! We want your kids to feel welcome and included, too. We'll provide a TrinityKids coloring sheet for each of your kids every Sunday. We only ask that you please bring along your own crayons.

10. Will the café be open?

We will not be providing coffee and refreshments until further notice.

11. Will the restrooms be available for use?

Yes, the restrooms on the Main Level and nearest the Multipurpose Room will be available for use and properly cleaned and sanitized before and after every gathering. If possible, we encourage you to use the restroom before you come.

12. Will we practice social distancing?

Yes, we will be practicing social distancing while gathered together. See "What to Expect" for more details.

13. Will we share communion together?

Yes! For now, we plan to share communion every other week. Communion elements will be pre-packaged and self-served. We will share communion together in a way that encourages social distancing.

14. Will there be singing?

Yes! This may feel uncomfortable at first, but we plan to sing with our masks on for the time being.

15. Can I come if I'm not feeling well?

While we miss you and can't wait to gather with you again, if you're sick and/or experiencing any of the following symptoms, or if you've had contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days, we ask that you please stay home:

- cough
- shortness of breath or chest tightness
- sore throat
- nasal congestion/runny nose
- myalgia (body aches)
- loss of taste and/or smell
- diarrhea
- nausea
- vomiting
- fever/chills/sweats
